While sitting in the Alabama Pastor's conference in Montgomery on Monday night, a very red-faced and rude man slaps me on the shoulder and says "Read this and when you get finished, give me a call!" and then he walked away. I was handed a gospel tract at a pastor's conference. I have to admit, it was extremely humorous in the beginning. However, the more I pondered and actually looked at the booklet, (which is a testimony about a man saved in prison. I mean do I really look like a convict? Don't answer that!) the more torn I became. Was it his reasoning because I was not wearing a suit and tie like many of the men in attendance? Was the Holy Spirit leading him to try and save a youth minister who doesn't always conform to the normal ideals? I cannot figure out what his motif was, but I want to call and give him a piece of my mind. The way I want to respond would lead him to believe he was right in giving me the information. I realized that I have been learning 2 very important lessons: 1.) Be careful that I do not come across arrogant with the Gospel. It is not about me. And 2.) Never assume that someone is not a Christian by the way that person looks, but never assume someone is a Christian. God is so amazing and can use a ridiculous, grumpy man to teach me a lesson or two.
